Preventing Measles

Most people today have never experienced caring for a child with measles. It is very contagious and dangerous for infants and young children—28% must be hospitalized. Possible complications include pneumonia, lifelong brain damage, deafness and even death.

The American Academy of Family Physicians, American Academy of Pediatrics, and the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention strongly recommend children receive all vaccines, including Measles, Mumps, Rubella (MMR) shot, per the recommended schedule.

In spite of this recommendation, some parents still choose not to immunize their children. Anyone fearing the MMR or any other immunization should talk to their doctor to get the facts about safety. Summer Youth Program

Due to previous success, "*Kids' Camp: Fun, Food, Fitness*", sponsored by the Community Health/Wellness Alliance of Hopkins County, has been planned for another summer camp program, for 2015. The camp targets students who will have completed grades 1 thru 4.

The focus will be on fitness and health, with activities in four areas:

- 2) Physical activity

Fridays will be led by Extension Master Gardeners, as they conduct container gardening and other plant/gardening activities.

Mondays & *Wednesdays* will focus on nutrition and physical activity, with 30 minutes allotted for sessions on safety. I need your assistance in leading sessions on nutrition, selecting healthy foods, simple hands-on food preparation activities, and other related topics.
